If this report does not hit the press, every week it can be researched on our website www.eatonandhollis.co.uk. Another successful market but not quite as many cattle about, 75 OTMS, Certainly not our share in view of the trade we have and it would be helpful if entries were earlier, overall average was 93p/kg due to the fact there were more hard worked Holsteins forward.

In the clean cattle and bulls sections there were 150 forward. 25% of Bulls averaged 169p/kg, 25% of Heifers averaged 167p/kg, 25% of Steers averaged 163p/kg. It was the general feeling that we had out performed other markets. The highlight in the Bull section was from GH Paddock of Stone who had 6 Bulls in to average 177p/kg and of course the Ottewell Family had their usual good quality cattle forward to a top of 177p/kg.

Sheep section averaged 7-10p/kg more than 3 local markets and 14.5p/kg more than a market to the south which is the equivalent to £6 on a 40kg lamb of course. Top price was £94 for Fred Yates.
