The Dearest Yet – A slightly improved entry met a trade that nobody has ever seen before with all cattle pounds dearer than they have been. Very strong competition around the ring with feeders needing to fill sheds and many regular bidders going home empty handed.

Trade today peaked at £1150 for a good Limousin steer (27 months) from the Thompson family, Measham with others from the same home at £1090 and £1070. Heifers from the same home peaked at £1070 for a pair of Charolais (17 months) with their entry of 9 steers and heifers averaging £1024.

Angus and Hereford Cattle are always in demand at Derby and a couple of good ones today peaked at £775 for Angus steers from Messrs Robinson Partners, Burton on Trent whilst Hereford steers topped at £1060 and £1020 (20-21 months) from J W Shepherd & Son, Burton on Trent and heifers from the same home at £875 (20 months). A bunch of 6 lean Holstein steers (16-19 months) sold at £665 whilst young Simmental heifers sold at £710 from A P Danvers, Coalville.
