Highlight for the steers was for a grass bullock for RH Naylor for 187p/Kg = £1376.

Derby sheep numbers on the rise with a tremendous entry of 727 this week. Also a new buyer operating with particular interest in the Leaview lambs.

All in all an excellent day in the sheep section with lamb prices well up on the same penned last year. Some very high quality consignments found with prices to match. Cull ewes as dear as anyone can remember with the overall average an astonishing £95.07.

The 643 lambs encompassing a broad spread of quality. Before comparing these prices too closely it should be remembered that Derby lambs are usually fresh from the fields and many are sold without a period held up prior to being weighed.

There were however, some superb specimens for which Derby is famous as this time of year when down country lambs are losing their bloom.
