

## DERBY LIVESTOCK MARKET Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2011

### **PRIME CATTLE - Auctioneer: Charles Hollis**

An extremely good market, large numbers in all departments, 100 OTMS, 100 Bulls, 100 Clean, 848 Sheep, 155 Calves, 14 Dairy Cows and 40 Stores.

Highlight of the day was 22 Bulls from Stuart Dore of Palterton & GH Paddock of Stone averaging 186.7p/Kg with a top of 200p/Kg and averaging £1253 per head.

Top 25% of averages, Bulls – 192p/Kg, Steers – 186p/Kg, Heifers – 186p/Kg, OTMS – 145p/Kg OTMS to a top of 184p/Kg and £1393 for a Charolais from Mr Bowden.

A run of Bulls from A&VA Thompson of Heage averaged 196p/Kg and a run of Bulls from Atkin Brothers averaged 189p/Kg.

200 Clean Cattle and Bulls averaged 166.28p/Kg.

The overall cattle average was extremely good, numbers were obviously extremely good, proves a point that Bakewell on the same day makes no difference at all.

### **PEDIGREE CATTLE – Auctioneer: Oliver Hiles**

A really good entry for pedigree week of quality cows and heifers met a full ring of buyers and a superb trade prevailed.

The pedigree catalogue attracted a supplementary entry of commercial cows and heifers and a good feeling was around the ring.

Largest consigner of the day was Messrs Border Holdings at Kenilworth who consigned 7 good heifers and cows and it was one of these that made top price on the day. The fresh heifer looked the part and sold for £1,790 with their 4 heifers averaging £1,725.

The Archer family consigned 5 good Friesian type heifers from their renowned Collycroft herd and these sold to a top of £1,560 with their entire entry averaging £1,470.

More Friesian heifers today from Brian Dalby, a regular consigner at Derby and his 2 strong heifers sold for £1,530 and £1,500.
