What a week! Catalogue Sale, Red Market Sale and a well supported normal market Thursday 3rd November. The cat is back and fortunately the mice have scarpred without causing the necessity for any deaths. The market was well supported but short of quality because a lot of cattle were showing the weather and we were short of four quality suppliers who could not attend because of the six day rule. Trade was again very good, to say exceptional would not be an exaggeration.

If you read last weeks Farmers Guardian you will see that Derby was top in the OTMs. This week 100 OTMs 114.44p/Kg 134 prime 182.65 p/Kg. Top highest priced OTM 180p/Kg FW Austin Parwich, 177.70p/Kg from Messrs CE Cook & Son Leicestershire. Top overall price for OTMs £1238 Aberdeen Angus for D S Sault Yoxall, £1136 Simmental for AJ Minshall, no need to tell you where Mr Minshall lives.

Bulls highest price was Limousin 219p/Kg for J Watson, Alfreton. 218 and 214p/Kg for AE Barlow & Co Staffs and J Ottewell, Stainsby sold Limousin 210p/Kg. W R Sessions, Derby realised the same. Atkins Bros Simmental 208p/Kg. Top individual price £1489, 1472 W R Sessions, Derby and 1410 J Agricultural, Loughborough. A lot were over £1300. Steers highest priced 208p/Kg Limousin for K Baxter, Markfield, 204p/Kg FW Austin, with a lot over 200p/Kg. Highest individual prices for the Steers were 1280 Mr Allen Uttoxeter, £1265 W Stretton & Son Etwell, £1255 H Thompson, Staffs and £1241 Mr Gagie staffs.
