Good Entry. Stuart Dore kept top position rubbing shoulders with John Ottewell. Dore's Bulls realised 218p/Kg, 217 p/Kg Atkins to 215 p/Kg, 209 p/Kg and GN & SM Seals, Crich to 215 p/Kg.
