Another exceptionally good market almost 250 cattle forward, could have sold a lot more. Compared to other markets trade was outstanding. 70 OTMS avg 129.46p/Kg, top 25% avg 165.46p/Kg. The highest prices were 187p/Kg and 175p/Kg as shown below.

Highest price overall was £1341 for H A Howson, Yoxall. 25% of Bulls had an amazing avg of 202.39p/Kg whilst Holsteins avg 163p/Kg.

A & V A Thompson of Heage had an entry of 5 to avg 199p/Kg, R Rowlinson of Ilam had Bulls realising 202p/Kg and 196p/Kg.

Steers – the better continental cattle were of very similar quality, top 20% avg 182.67p/Kg
